Print in color on white cardstock. Laminate and cut cards apart. You will also need dry erase markers and a dry eraser.

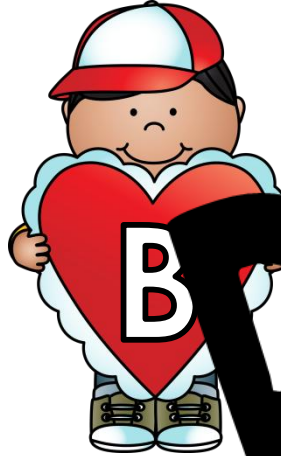
How to use: Ask students to look at the uppercase letter on the heart. Have them circle all the letters that are the same as the uppercase letter on the heart.

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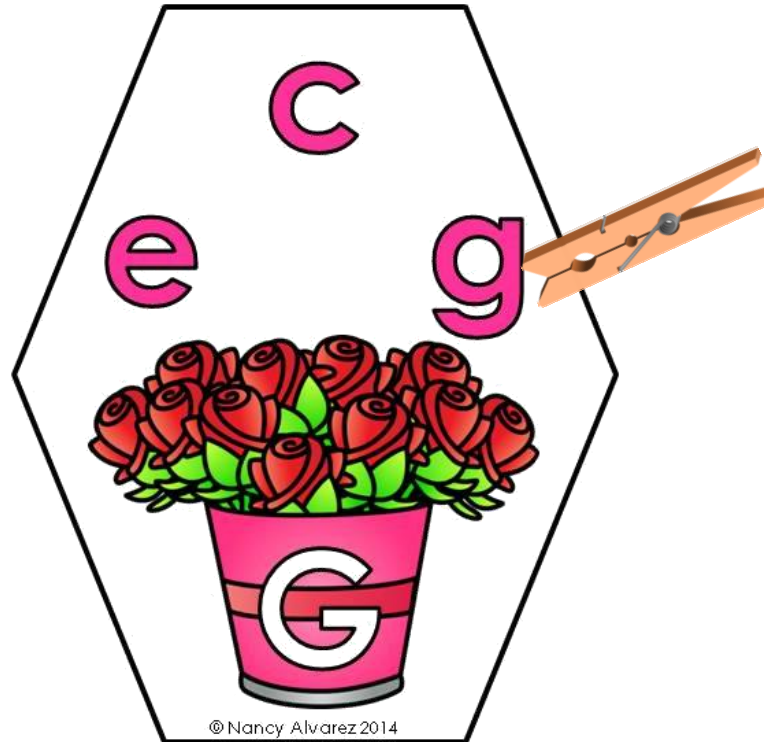

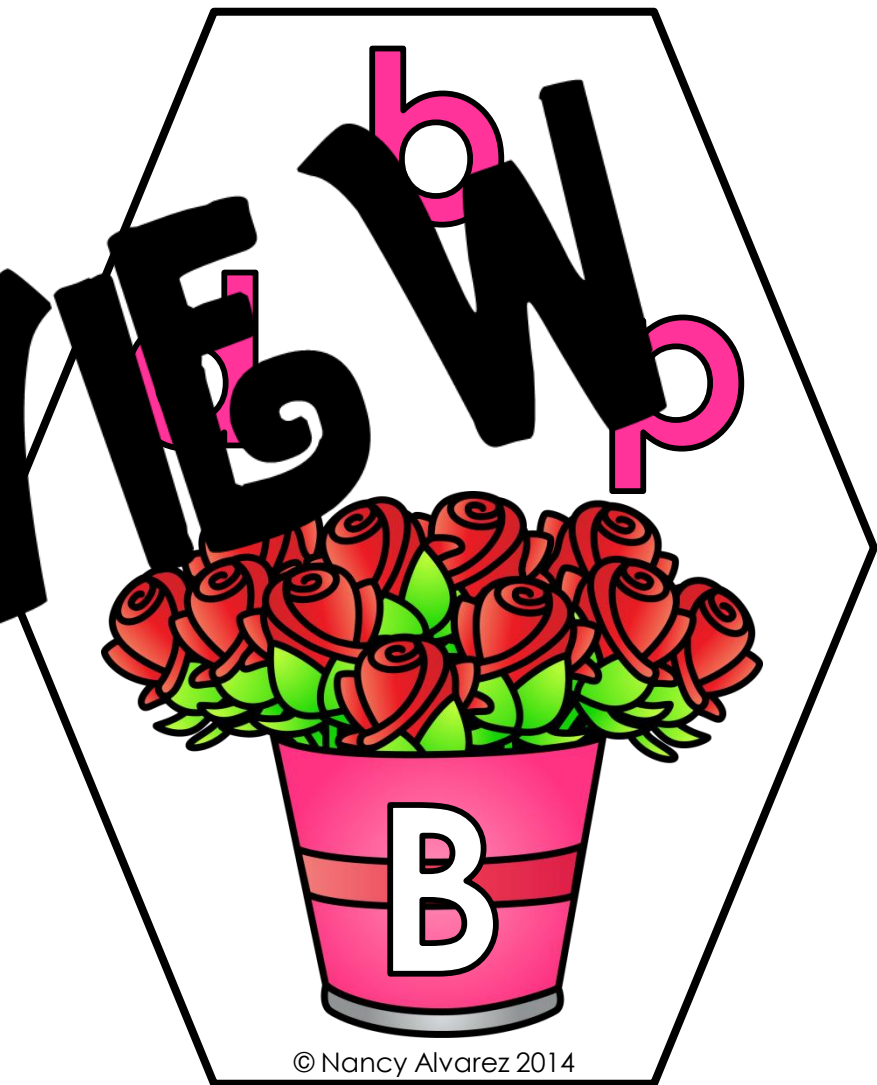
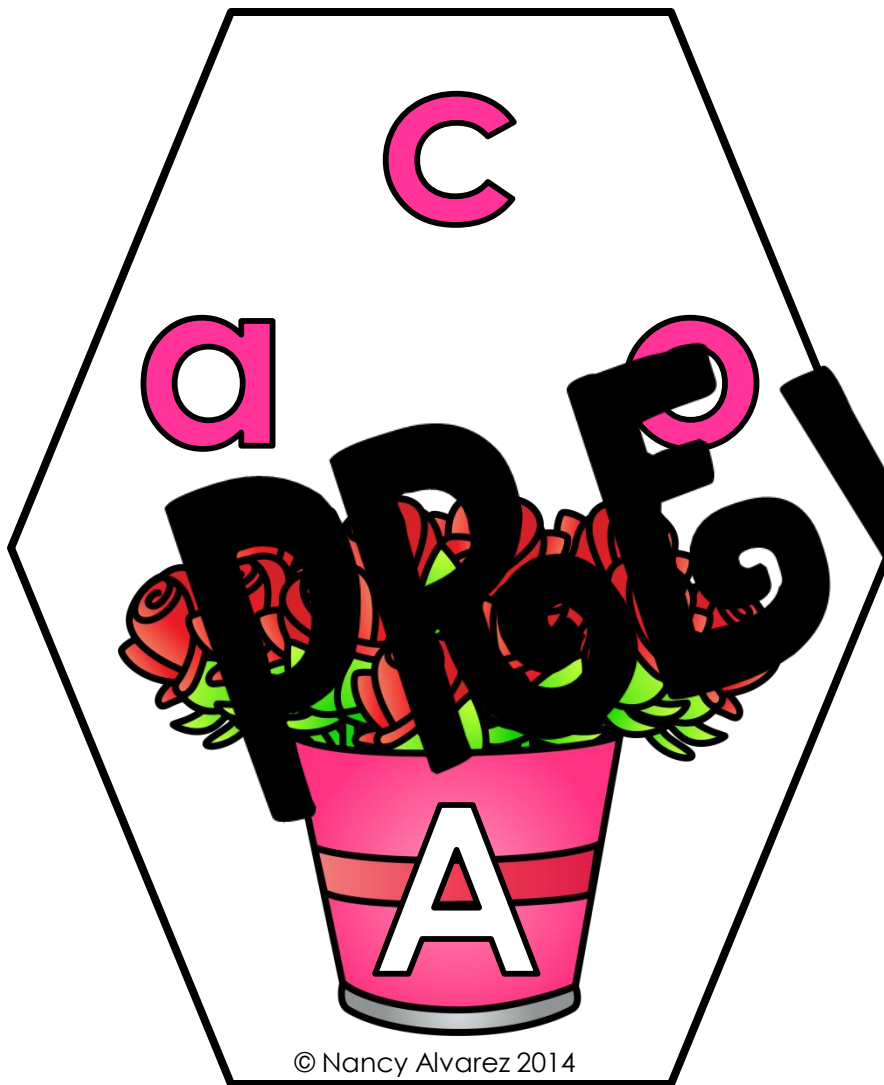
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# Instructions

How to use: Look at the uppercase letter on the flowerpot. Place a clothespin over the lowercase letter to make a match.

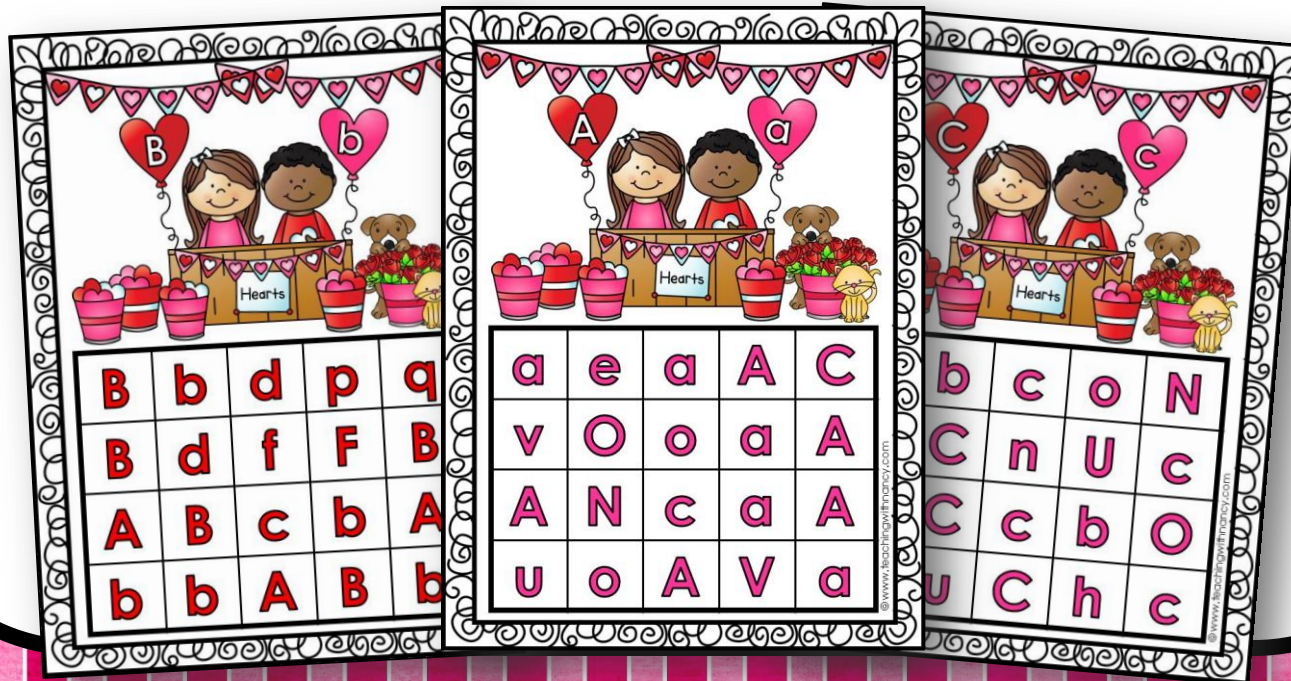




# Instructions

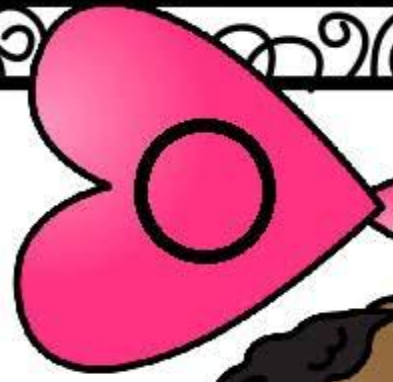
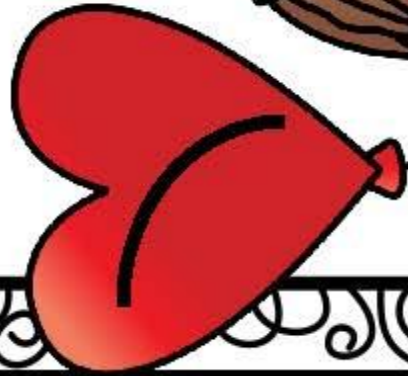
Print in color on white cardstock. Laminate for durability. You may use the heart letters provided or your own tactile letters.





