How to Use

Independent Station

Use picture and syllable cards to play a traditional memory game. Teaching Tip: Differentiate by providing some or all the cards. Review the vocabulary (names of pictures) ahead of time.

Iransition Activity

Pass out a picture cand to half the class and a syllable card to the other half. Say one of the syllables aloud. The student holding the picture card that begins with that syllable and student holding that syllable may (line up, go to centers, etc.)

Whole Group activity

Pass out a picture card to half the class and a syllable card to the other half. Ask students to find the classmate that is holding the picture or syllable card that makes a match with theirs




Independent Station








Picture Names: mapa, mano, calle, calabaza, taza, tacón

Print in color on white cardstock. Laminate for durability and cut cards apart. Make multiple copies of the answer recording sheet. Provide students with dry erase markers, clothespins or small manipulatives so they can indicate the correct answer on the card. Note: There are two sets of this activity that look almost identical. The sets are color coded, black set and blue set. Teacher Tip: Make sure the answer recording sheet matches the clip card set students are working with.
