




How to Use

Staple or tape the cupcake counting cards around the room (or place them at a center). Have students walk around the room and count the cupcakes and record their answers on the answer recording sheet. After counting the cupcakes on all ten cards students can go back to their seats and color in the ten frames. When they are finished counting, writing the number and completing the ten frames, they may scan the QR code on the answer recording sheet to check their work.












How to Use

Staple or tape the QR code cards around the room (or place them at a center). Students write the number they hear on the answer recording sheet. After scanning all ten cards students can go back to their seats and color in the ten frames.
