

# Preparation Instructions

Print in color on white cardstock. Laminate for durability and cut cards apart. Make multiple copies of the answer recording sheet. (Optional: print student friendly instructions.) Staple or tape cards around the room or place them at a center.

*Teaching Tip:* Review the name of the pictures ahead of time.

Provide students with a smart device with an app that can scan and read QR codes. If you don't already have a QR code scanner app on your smart device, you may want to download this one <http://apple.co/lqv52BT> from the iTunes store for FREE. It is easy to use and has no ads.

## How to Use

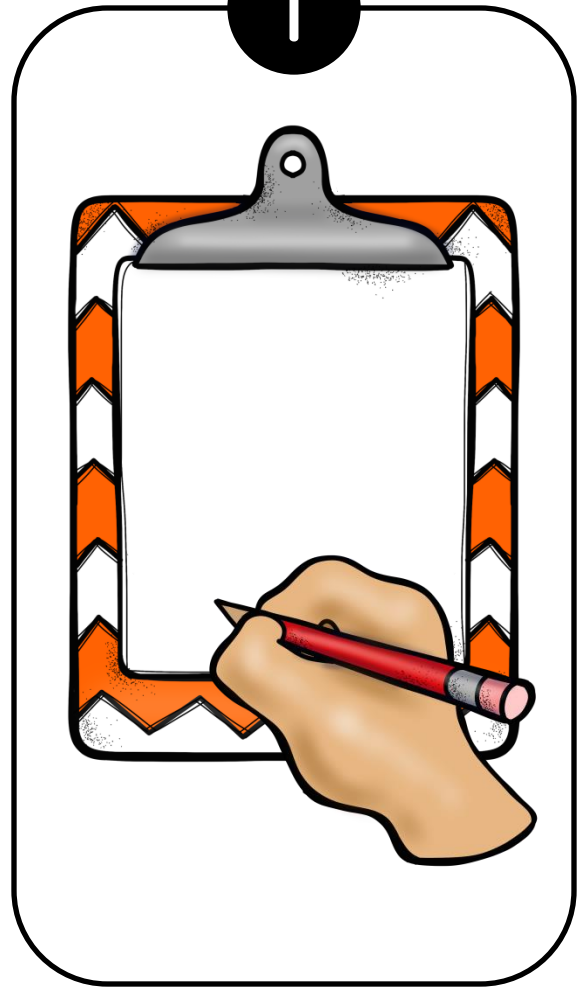

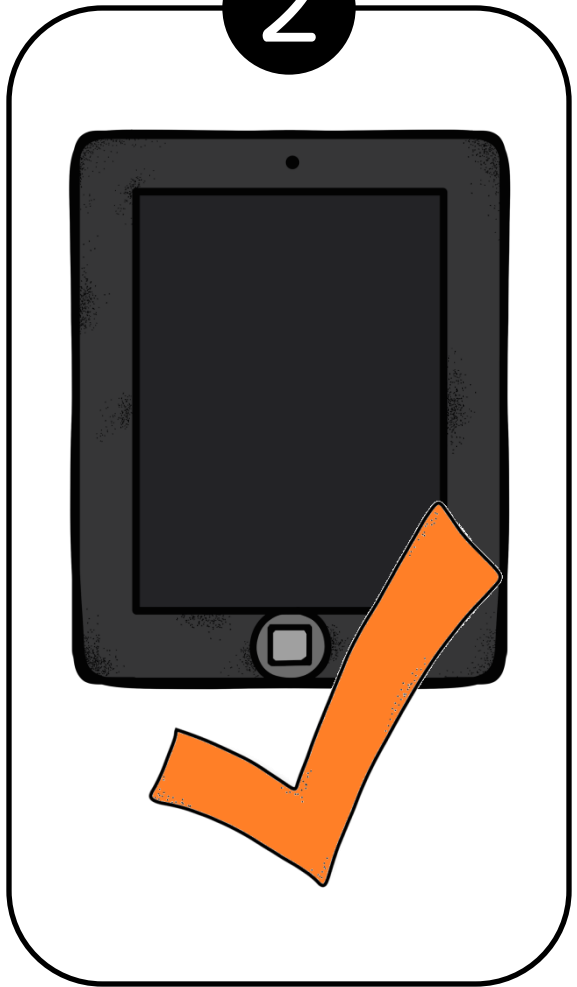

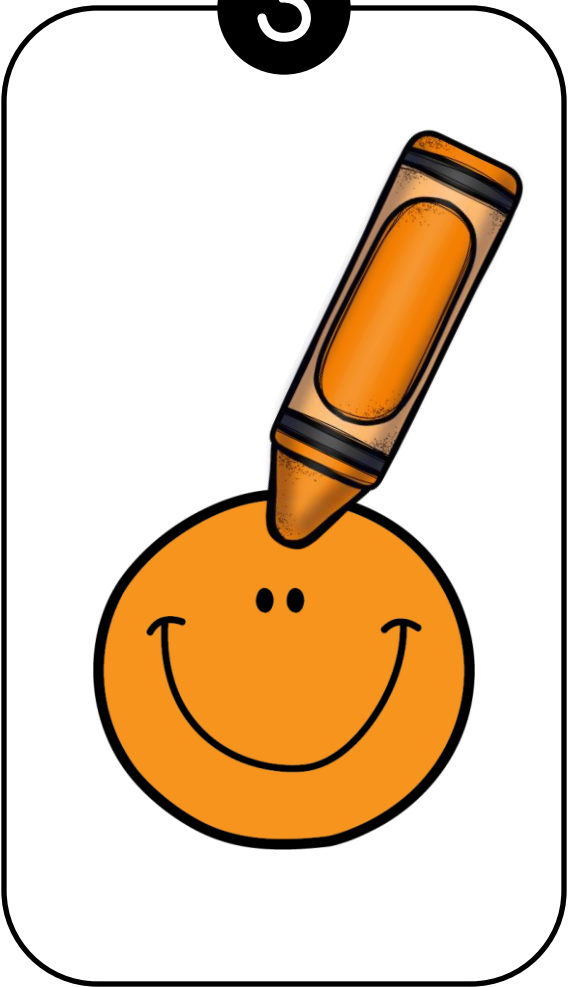
